Adams Pointe Golf Club Showcases Improved Course Conditions

Blue Springs, MO. (June 24, 2005) — Adams Pointe Golf Club is now, once again, one of the premier courses to play in Kansas City. With the support of the city of Blue Springs, Adams Pointe Golf Club unveils a revamped course offering golfers a new and exciting golf experience.

“It was time to make a change, and the city of Blue Springs proactively supported our ideas,” said Brian Dutler, general manager, Adams Pointe Golf Club. “With so many golf courses in the Kansas City metro area and new ones going in each year, we needed to use our respected course layout as the foundation to create great course conditions.”

Fairways have been converted to bent grass to green up earlier in the spring and improve playability, and new zoysia tee boxes will be more resilient for quicker divot repair. Finally, players can now easily gauge more accurate distance from tee to green with new distance-marked cart paths and curbs. Beginning in April, golf carts started coming standard with GPS systems for added convenience and accuracy to measure distances.

“Our course changes come directly from player feedback, which we incorporated into our improvement plan for 2005,” said Dutler. “It’s exciting to see these ideas become a reality with support from our community.”

In addition to a better conditioned course, Adams Pointe is offering many unique programs this year as well. One example is the new player development program. Priced at \$35, the program includes unlimited range balls, instructional golf clinics and a nine-hole green fee anytime during the week for ten dollars during certain time frames.

Adams Pointe Golf Club is an 18-hole championship golf course that completed its course enhancement program in the fall of 2004.
